His current research interests include biomaterials and tissue engineering with special focus on bioceramics and bioactive glasses, as well as processing and testing of advanced ceramics. He is member of the American Ceramic Society. Prof. Baino has been Section Editor-in-Chief of Materials (MDPI), and currently is Associate Editor of the International Journal of Applied Ceramic Technology (Wiley) and Frontiers in Bioengineering and Biotechnology. He has published more than 250 peer-reviewed journal articles and book chapters with an H-index of 53, and is author of 3 patents. According to a scientometric study published in PLOS Biology, since 2021 he is is among the 2% top-cited scientists in the world.
